NEW CONTRACT WON – MANAGEMENT, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF CROSS-HARBOUR TUNNEL, HONG KONG

Serco has successfully won a new 6-year contract to Manage, Operate and Maintain the Cross-Harbour Tunnel in Hong Kong. The Cross-Harbour Tunnel is the oldest tunnel under the Victoria Harbour in Hong Kong connecting Kellett Island (a former island now connected to Hong Kong Island by reclamation) and Hung Hom Bay, Kowloon. Geographically and strategically placed on Hong Kong Route 1, the Cross-Harbour Tunnel is also the busiest tunnel in Hong Kong with over 120,000 vehicles travelling through daily and generating some HK\$700 million in annual toll revenue for the Hong Kong Government.

This is an important win for Serco in a highly competitive market. By winning this important contract, Serco will become the largest Tunnel Operator in Hong Kong with more than 600 staff managing, operating and maintaining four critical tunnels in Hong Kong. With the continued professionalism and contributions of all our staff, we are confident this sets the tone for Serco to capitalize on our strengths to help Hong Kong Government manage the new infrastructures such as the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macau Bridge and the Central Wanchai Bypass that are currently under construction.
